struggle to understand is hard. You have my promise that we will do our very best to comply with the guidelines and promises made overleaf. If you feel that you would rather keep your children safe at home then we fully understand. There is a list of activities you can order and we will deliver them in a box to you, if you decide that you would rather not attend any sessions. The activity boxes are available to all but with only limited resources priority will be given to those not participating in our LUP summer.

Spaces on sessions are really limited no more than 9 in the office and 15 if we are outside (with some exceptions). Can I ask that if you are allocated a place and find you don't want it for whatever reason please let us know ASAP. My suspicion is that waiting lists will be quite long for activities. As we can't book indoor space if we are outside, then we are outside. So where as normally we would rent a room to hide from the rain, we can't. Any doubt in bad weather call me 07979751893.

Claire will be allocating on Monday 13th July. Please get your bookings in early we are unlikely to have places after this date. COVID STATEMENT

We will do our very best to ensure that:

- 🗍 No member of staff will work if they are unwell
- 🗍 Hand sanitising and washing will take place regularly at sessions
- 🖊 When indoors no more than 9 children will be present
- 4 Children will be allocated to a staff member who will support them throughout the session.
- **We** will socially distance to at least one meter when sitting
- 🖊 Any child who becomes unwell will be sent home or isolated.
- 🖊 Every surface, toy and toilet will be sanitised at the start of the session
- 🖊 Our office has been deep cleaned, all bags and containers have been washed.
- 🖊 Sessions for more than 9 children will take place outdoors.
- 🖊 Unless needed coats will be sent home
- 🖊 No lunch boxes are allowed
- ✤ No toys from home are allowed
- 🗍 All biscuits and where possible snacks will be individually wrapped.
- ➡ No self-service for food allowed.
- **We** are offering a storage service if you don't want to take crafts home that day.
- 4 We will notify Track and Trace and families directly if a family member becomes covid positive.
- 🖊 All staff and children will have their temperature taken at the start of the session.

We are asking that parent / carers ensure that:

- ✤ No toys are bought to sessions
- 4 If your child needs a special diet please phone us in advance.
- 🖊 Please don't send your child if they are unwell in anyway.
- If your child is coughing due to asthma you must let us see their medication with their name on the label.
- 🖊 Please take coats home íf sessíon ís índoors
- 4 Please don't waste allocated places, they are going to be precious this summer.
- 🖊 Please turn up on time and collect on time. We must have time to clean after a session.
- 4 If a member of your family becomes Covid positive after a session you must tell us.

However despite this these are special children who don't fully understand social distancing in many cases, we will do our very best but can't guarantee. Parents will have to risk assess and decide for themselves if they accept the risk.

You must bring your own picnic chairs, blankets (to keep warm) or umbrellas. There will be a BBQ and drink selection





Sorry we can't stay all day like we have in previous years. In order to socially distance we need to split the children into 2 groups changing over at lunch time. The lunch time changeover is a bit tight so please drop off and collect on time.

Because the children are not together we can take larger numbers on this activity. Start times are split 15 minutes apart as are collection times. Claire will look at who is booking and assign them a group and a start and finish time. 9:45 is the first slot last collection slot is 3:15. If there is an activity your child insists they must do (you can look at the website) then you must tell Claire when booking. We can't change children over on the day. Children need a packed lunch. We will bring snacks for break and additional drinks. Lunch times will be staggered. Staff will stay with the same group all day.
