I do have plenty of tests at the office but I am not allowed to test the children without quite a complicated bit of parental consent. If you wanted a test for your child, we could help. ## **Compass.....A new project for Let Us Play.**

Funded by Wolverhampton's Headstart, Compass is especially for young people who are currently in year 6 or above up to the age of 18 years. There are 30 places. We are asking that you sign up to the project which initially will run for 11 months starting from this newsletter. The activities will be aimed at older young people and will be very wide in what we offer. The difference is that only those who sign up to the project at the beginning can book places on those activities which are designated by the compass logo off this newsletter and in future newsletters. Your name and date of birth will be shared with the funder, but no other details such as disability or address will be shared, by signing up this implies consent. You must have a WV postcode. We understand that not all the activities will be of interest to all the young people all the time, however if you sign up to Compass then we must ask that whenever possible you do attend at least one session off each newsletter. Having said that with sessions run at the office I still can't take 30 even if we had the room because of Covid protocols. If for instance you are always out of city on a Saturday then please don't sign up as you will be taking a place away from somebody who can attend. Just tell Claire you want to be part of Compass, as she will do the paperwork on your behalf. I know your next question will be sign up for what?? So on this newsletter Alton Towers is only for Compass young people, as is Ice cream cup cakes, and horse riding. As we move forward the young people can have input into what we do. I am sorry but there are no 1:1 places on compass and ratio of staff to young people is 1:5 so no intensive support either.






