Welcome to the Easter newsletter. The government have announced HAF will continue for a further year. However, WCC are not going to fund activities during half terms throughout 2025. For children to be eligible for HAF you need to have an EHCP, there isn't any need to give us your code as most children will be registered on the system. If you are new to LUP and Wolverhampton based, but don't have a EHCP then please consider speaking to your school about getting one. We do still take children without one, but the funding generated by the code has become essential to our delivery program. There are Staffordshire activities on this newsletter, however please try and book through Staffordshire Connects. We get lots of feedback about how busy the lines are and how difficult it can be to hang on for ages, but they simply don't let us book places until much closer to the delivery date. Normally all the places have gone by the time Claire can add children to the list. We have passed on your frustrations, but I believe the bookings line has multiple functions for Staffordshire Council and there isn't a lot that can be done due to the cost of a dedicated line.


## Wednesday 7th May LUP building
